

Peace Lutheran Church Confirmation Program

Classroom Expectations:

40 hours over the course of three years (6th-8th grades). An adult who is involved with the student's faith formation is expected to attend each class with the student. This need not be the same adult each time and includes parents, grandparents, and other adult role models.

10 hours of Catechism offered in four different courses:	Apostle's Creed	3 hours
	10 Commandments	3 hours
	Lord's Prayer	2 hours
	Sacraments	2 hours
10 hours of Lutheran Living offered in three different courses:	Grace and the Reformation	3 hours
	Lutheran Theology	3 hours
	Changing World	4 hours
20 hours of Scripture offered in six different courses:	Torah	4 hours
	Prophets	3 hours
	History	3 hours
	Poetry	2 hours
	Gospels	5 hours
	Epistles	3 hours

Faith Skills Expectations:

Worship Reflections	20 reflections must be completed in three years and must include at least two different worship styles. Styles include praise service, heritage service, celebration service, weddings, funerals, and ordinations/commissionings.
Worship Leadership	The students must service as a worship leader at least 20 times in three years. Worship leadership includes acolyting, ushering, reading, communion assisting, singing in the choir, playing in the wind ensemble, or AV. (Required training will be provided.)
Fellowship	The student must participate in at least two fellowship event during each of the three years of confirmation (6 th -8 th grades).
Service	The student must participate in at least two service project during each of the three years of confirmation (6 th -8 th grades).
Faith Education	15 hours of faith education must be completed. This includes an adult or youth faith formation class (1 hour each) or a confirmation retreat or week at camp (5 hours each).

Final Project:

Each student will complete a project after completing their classroom and faith skills expectations. The project will be due in the fall of the following year. The student may choose from one of these three options:

Create a Confirmation Lesson	The student will create an hour long lesson for one of the confirmation courses.
Teach a Confirmation Lesson	The student will be given the opportunity to teach a prepared lesson from the curriculum.
Create a Worship Service	The student will create a worship service to be used by the church including the selection of music and writing of prayers.
